dearest to our hearts (every one of you).

I would be available to Starkdale from time to time, but only by invitation from the new pastor and the session.

Whether it is to participate in a funeral, perform a wedding, lead a study, or fill the pulpit, the pastor through the session, not individuals, must issue the invitation. I do this out of respect for your new pastor and the leadership of your elders. Needless to say that this is the way it is done. Often, it is wise not to involve former pastors in the work of the church, so the new pastor may have the opportunity to bond with the congregation.

I would consider joining in your celebrations and special events as often as I am able. But please understand two things: A) when I find it difficult to join you on a certain occasion, it is not for any reason other than the circumstances and/or my new obligations. B) Sometimes, former pastors are uncomfortable visiting with their former congregations for fear of being "caught in the middle" so to speak as church members share about new church problems. Also, the new pastor is often uncomfortable when the church is frequently visited by former pastors. New pastors may be hindered from following their own style of ministry if the former "influence" is still present among the congregation.

I would not turn anyone who is a member of the Starkdale church away from joining any community group of people I may lead in teaching the scriptures. Here, I request that you may not let your participation in my ministry substitute for your membership and services at Starkdale. Starkdale is where you have been called to serve and to grow in the Lord. Come and learn, but then return

to Starkdale and fulfill your Christian obligations to it.

I would rejoice with you, upon hearing of great things that may be happening in your ministry. There is no room in my heart for jealousy or envy. This is so because Jesus Christ is the one who uses us all in accordance to our gifts and for his glory.

I would, if it is God's will for us to move to another state in the future, keep in touch with you and visit from time to time. I have a great desire to know what your children and grandchildren, whom I now know by name, have done with their lives under God's blessings and protection. Also, I will follow your news through your website, the Chimes, and articles in your local newspaper.

I would be more than delighted to correspond with you VIA email over biblical matters. Emails that pertain to one's spiritual life would have my full attention.

I would, to the end of my life, even on my death bed, recall Starkdale to mind and reminisce over how much you have meant to Vickey and me and how sincere and genuine your friendship has been to us. Starkdale came to our lives in the right time. Two churches, prior to coming to Steubenville, made me doubt if church structures (what people call 'organized religion') was from God. God showed me through you that the structure of the church is never the problem, but the people who abuse the structure are. I was truly blessed to have Starkdale as my new church family. It brought hope to Vickey and me at a time when we needed divine assurance.
